Research Subject:

The ISSP seeks an outstanding candidate who develops elemental technologies for experiments at the next-generation high-brilliant synchrotron radiation facilities and supports joint-researches with the ISSP staffs at SPring-8 beamline BL07LSU. He/she is expected to make internal collaborations such as with interdisciplinary groups of functional materials or quantum materials. He/she is also expected to promote joint-researches actively with external researchers. We welcome any candidate from any field as long as he/she has leading idea and vitality, especially, in opening new fields of science and technology.

Application documents:

Applications should include the following documents prepared either in English or Japanese and should be sent by post or alternatively by E-mail to the address below.

All the documents must arrive no later than October 15, 2019.

- 1) CV with photo including academic record and professional career
- 2) Complete list of publications (mark five most important papers)
- 3) Copy of the five important papers marked above
- 4) Summary of research accomplishments (up to three pages)
- 5) Research plan (up to three pages).
- 6) Letter of recommendation (applicant should arrange a letter of recommendation to be sent directly from a recommender to ISSP)
