- 3. If you do not receive a confirmation e-mail from us after a week, contact the host laboratory.

7. Payment: To make the payment, please visit the Kyodo Riyou Gakari (共同利用係) on the

second floor in the ISSP Main Building (A in the map, page 1), during its office hours (9:00 – 16:30).

### 8. Check-in/check-out and key receipt/return:

[Check-in] You can check-in the room at or after 3:00 p.m. of the day of your stay. If you arrive at ISSP

before 16:30, you can receive the key from the aforementioned *Kyodo Riyou Gakari*. If you arrive later than that (or on weekends and public holidays), please receive the key from the gate keeper

stationed in the Gate House near the main entrance of the Kashiwa Campus.

[Check-out] You need to check out by 9:30 a.m. The key should be returned by dropping it off into the "Key Box" at the inside entrance of the Guesthouse. Please DO NOT drop off the key into the box until your final departure because once you return it, you cannot take it out from there.
