

A Research Associate Position
at the Institute for Solid State Physics (ISSP), the University of Tokyo

The ISSP invites outstanding candidates for a research associate position at Kimura Laboratory in Laser and Synchrotron Research Center. The successful candidate will explore frontier science using advanced X-ray sources and novel X-ray optics, investigating micro/nanostructure and physical properties of matters with unprecedentedly fine spatial and temporal resolutions with Prof. Kimura and users. We also expect he/she is highly motivated to develop a novel X-ray optics and to open a new field with the next-generation synchrotron radiation.

The initial appointment is for five years, and can be extended for an additional five years if the performance is satisfactory. The position is now open, and the term should start at the earliest possible date. Applicants must have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in a relevant field, or otherwise must receive a degree before the starting date of the appointment. Application should include the following documents prepared in either English or Japanese, and should be sent them by post or E-mail following the instructions below. **All the documents must arrive no later than November 30, 2020.**
