

A Research Associate Position
at the Institute for Solid State Physics (ISSP), the University of Tokyo

The ISSP is seeking outstanding candidates for a research associate position in the Neutron Science Laboratory. The successful candidate will collaborate with Prof. K. Mayumi and conduct vigorous experimental research on structure and dynamics of polymer and soft matter systems by means of neutron/X-ray scattering techniques. The successful candidate is also expected to play an active role in supervising laboratory activities of the graduate students and supporting joint-user-program on neutron science. The experience of neutron research is not necessary.

The initial appointment is for five years, and can be extended for an additional five years if the performance is satisfactory. The position is now open, and the term should start at the earliest possible date. Applicants must have a Ph.D. or equivalent degree in a relevant field, or otherwise must receive a degree before the starting date of appointment. Application should include the following documents prepared in either English or Japanese, and should be sent by post or E-mail following the instructions below. **All the documents must arrive no later than April 23, 2021.**
