Please write the abstract and submit it by Nov, 30th. Only Adobe PDF (\*.pdf) format is acceptable.

Please use this template according to the following rules:

- (1) The size of the paper should be A4 (210 x 297 mm<sup>2</sup>).
- (2) The top, bottom, left, and right margins of the printed area should be 22 mm.
- (3) The title should be written in the top box. Times New Roman or Times (bold and 15pt) is recommended.
- (4) The author's name and the affiliations should be written in the second box. The author's name should be written in 11pt size. The affiliations should be written in italic and 10pt size. Please keep it simple. Times New Roman (or Times) is recommended.

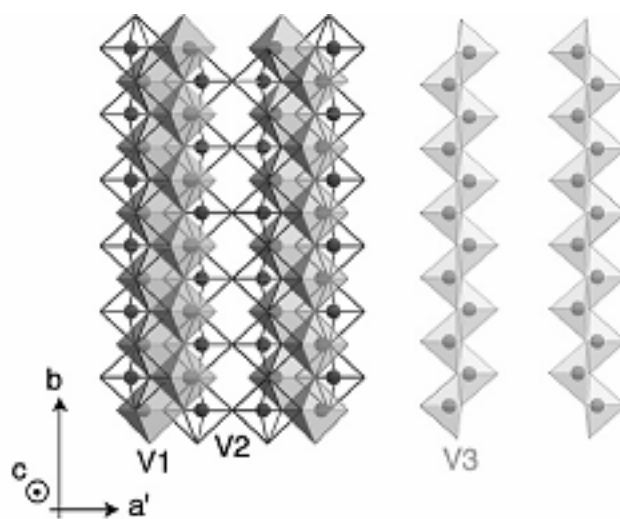


Figure 1: Structure of  $\beta\text{-Na}_{0.33}\text{V}_2\text{O}_5$

Color figures are acceptable, but please be sure that the manuscript including the figures will be printed out in grayscale.

The abstract should be limited to 1 page.
